Radcliffe-on-Trent Fish Scheme

The Fish Scheme helps elderly or disabled people who live in Radcliffe-on-Trent and the surrounding areas. There are three Day Centres a week: on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays, from 10.00am to 2.00pm (the Wednesday Day Centre is specifically for people with special needs or disabilities). There are a range of light activities including listening to music, sing-a-longs, dominos, cards, lunch, refreshments; and the opportunity to meet with other people for chat and friendship. The Day Centre is held at The Grange on Main Road, Radcliffe-on-Trent. The Day Centre is only available to people who have been referred by their Doctor to the scheme and have transport to and from the centre.
